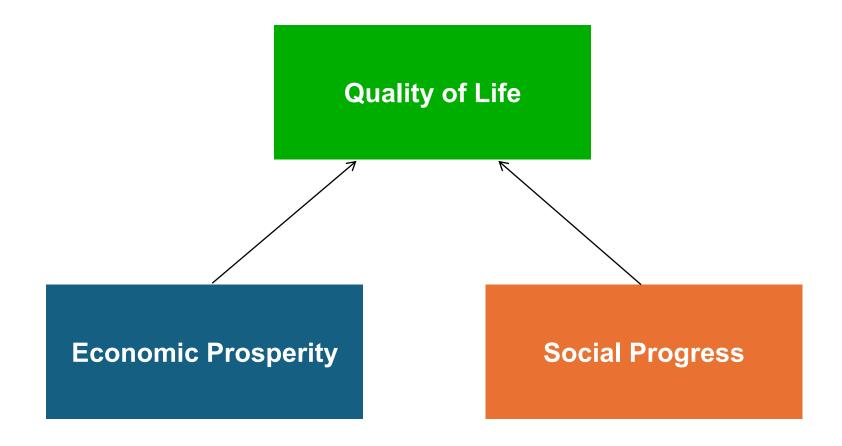

# What is Competitiveness?

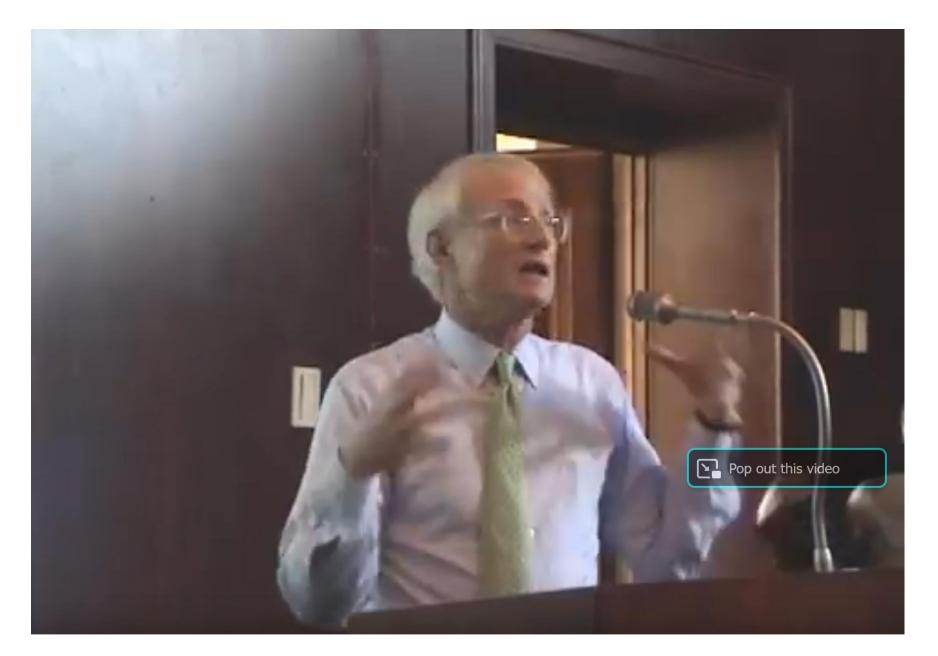
A country (or region) is competitive to the extent that firms operating there are able to **compete successfully** in the regional and global economy while supporting **high and rising wages and living standards** for the average citizen

- Competitiveness depends on the long-run productivity of a location as a place to do business
  - Productivity of existing firms and workers
  - Ability to achieve high participation of working age citizens in the workforce
- Competitiveness is **not**:
  - Low wages
  - A weak currency
  - Jobs per se

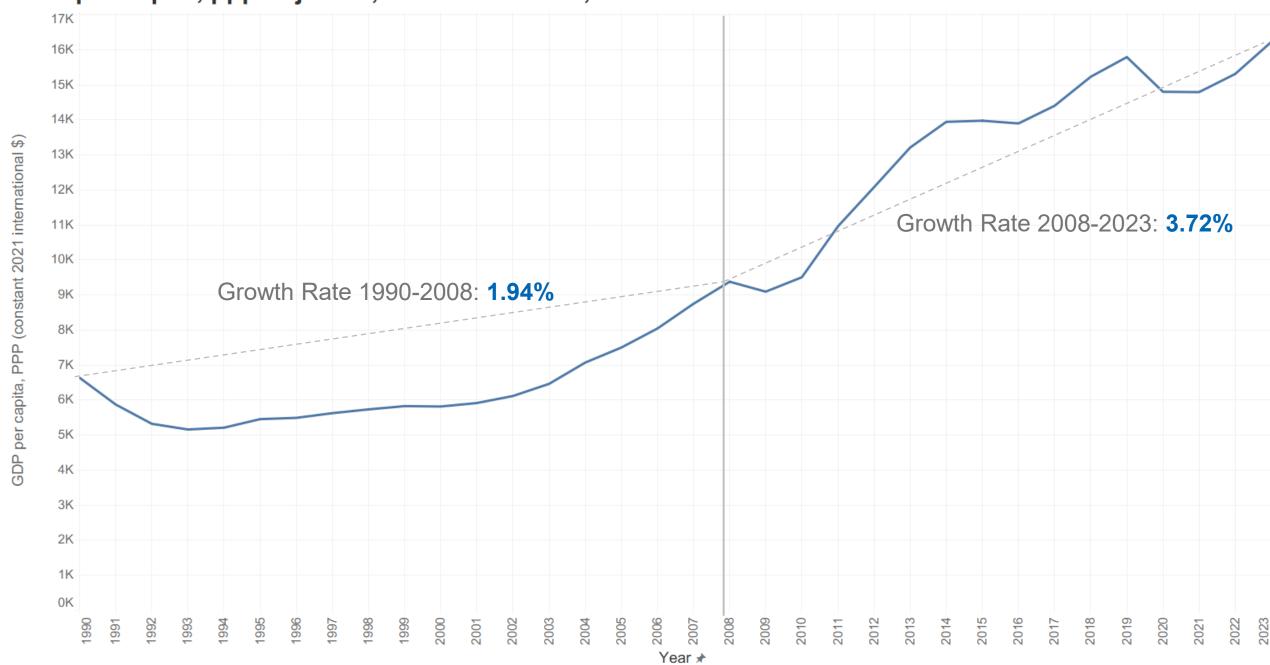

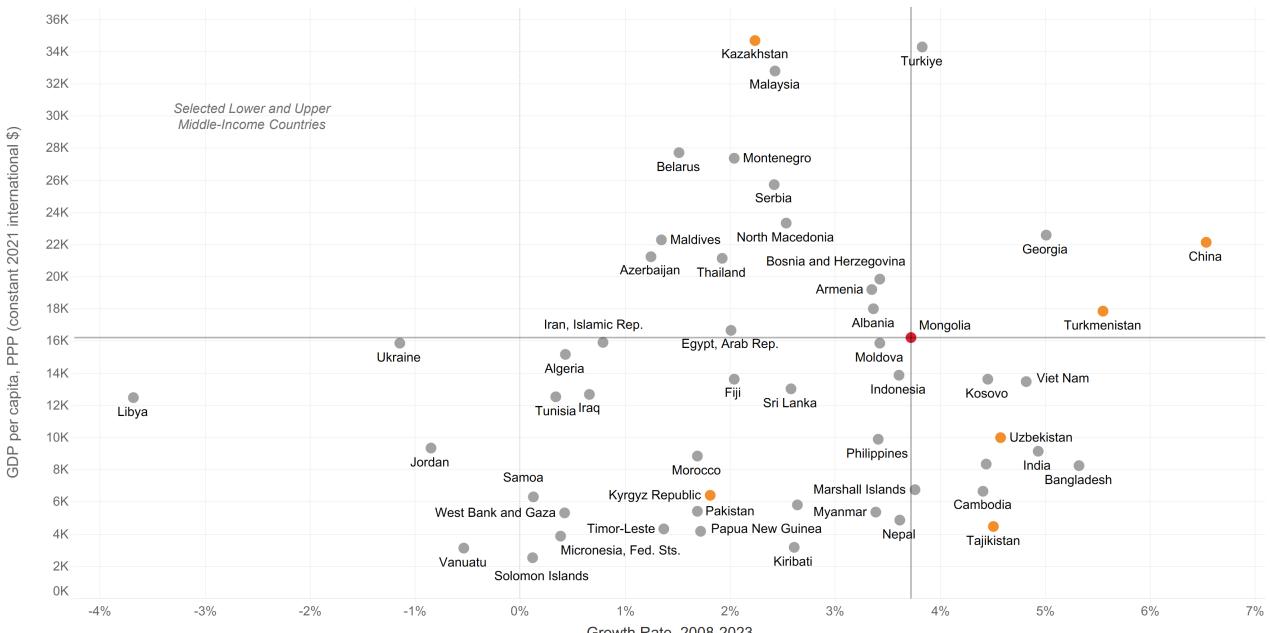


### GDP per capita, ppp-adjusted, constant dollars, 1990-2023

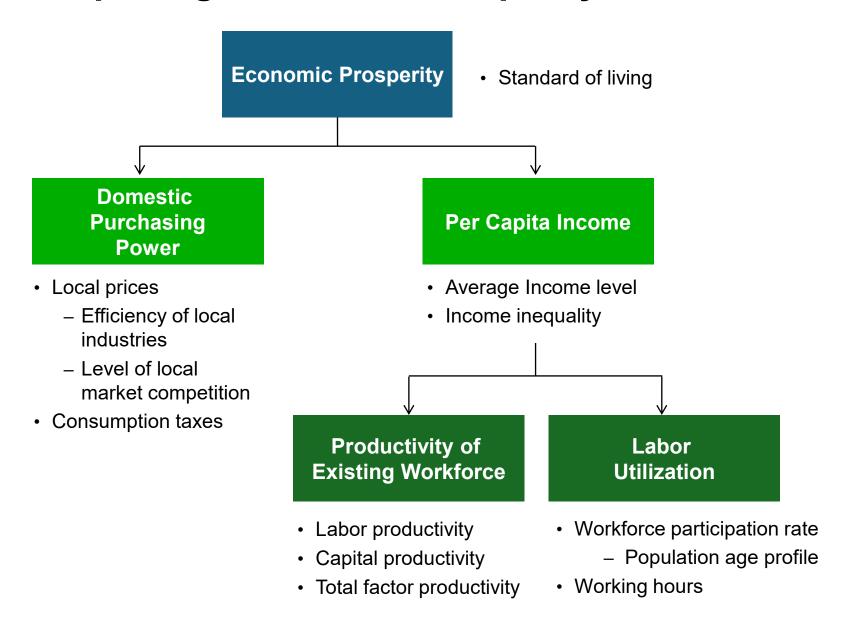


### **Comparative Prosperity Performance, 2008-2023**

GDP per capita, ppp-adjusted, constant dollars

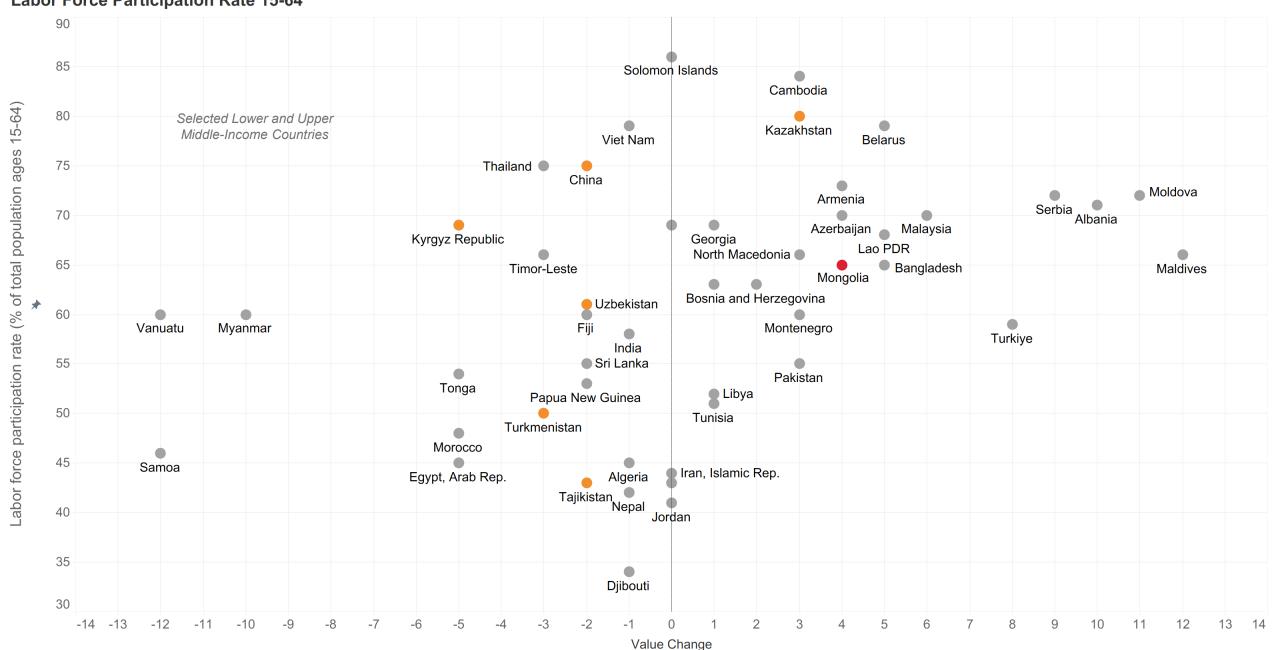

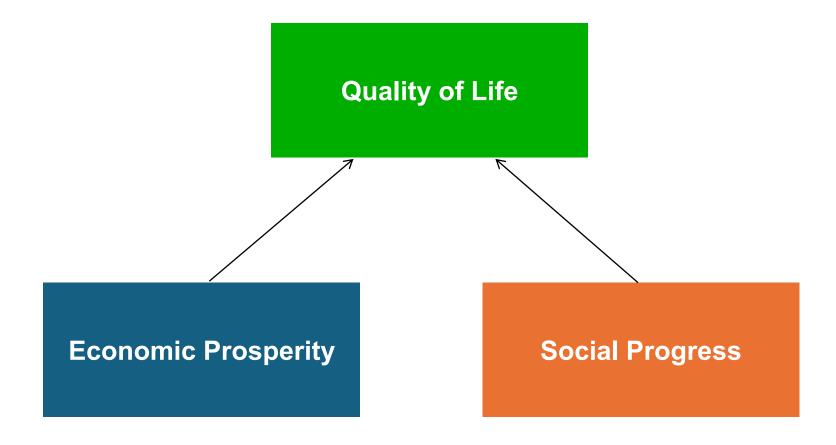


### **Comparative Prosperity Performance, 2008-2023**

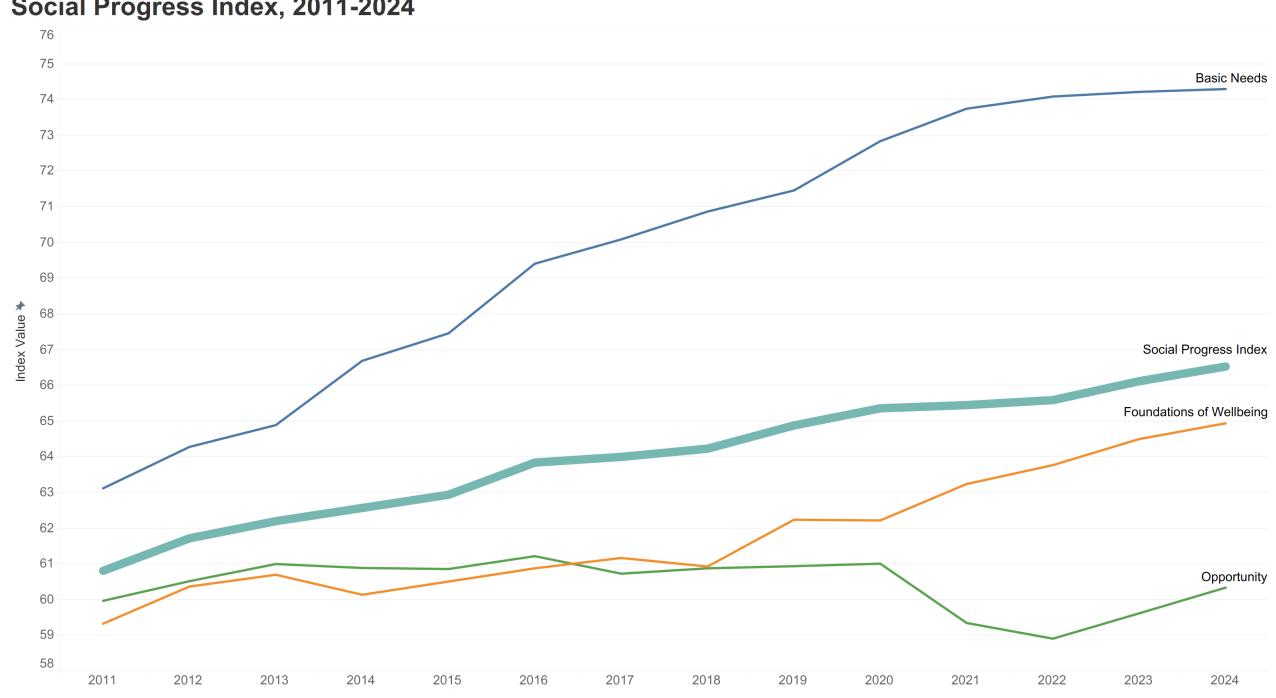

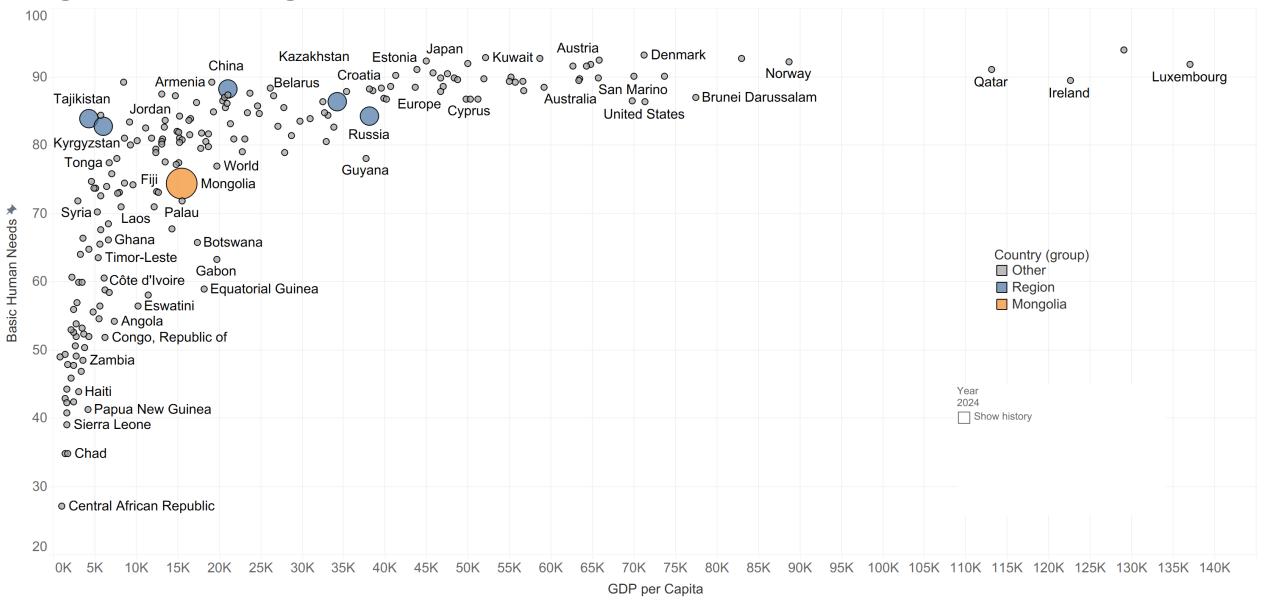

# The Basis of Prosperity

### **Inherited Prosperity**

- Prosperity derived from inherited natural resources / endowments
  - Prosperity is **limited** by the endowments themselves



- Dividing the pie
- Government usually becomes the central actor in the economy
- Resource revenues allow unproductive policies and practices to persist and fuel corruption

### **Created Prosperity**

- Prosperity arising from productivity in producing goods and services
  - Prosperity is unlimited



- Expanding the pie
- Companies are the central actors in the economy
- Government's role is to create the enabling conditions for productivity and foster private sector development

### **Endowments**

• Endowments create a foundation for prosperity, but true prosperity arises from productive use of endowments

# Sound Monetary and Fiscal Policies

- Fiscal Policy:
   Public spending aligned with revenues over time
- Monetary Policy: Interest rates, exchange rate, control of inflation
- <u>Economic</u>
   <u>Stabilization</u>: Avoiding structural imbalances and cyclical overheating

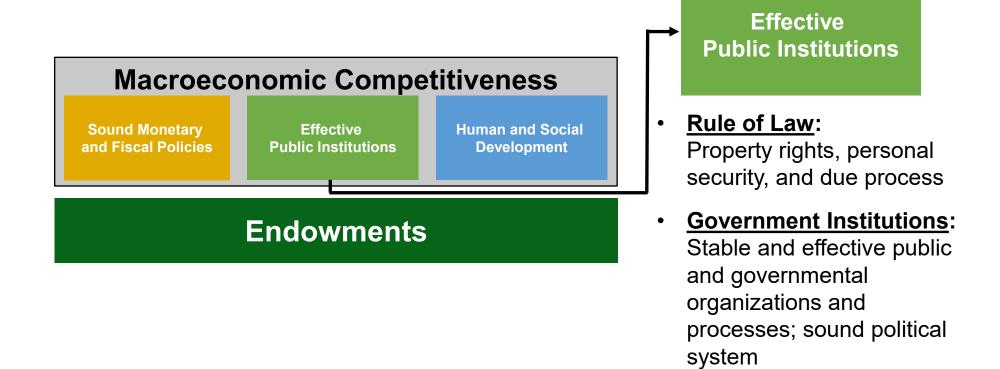

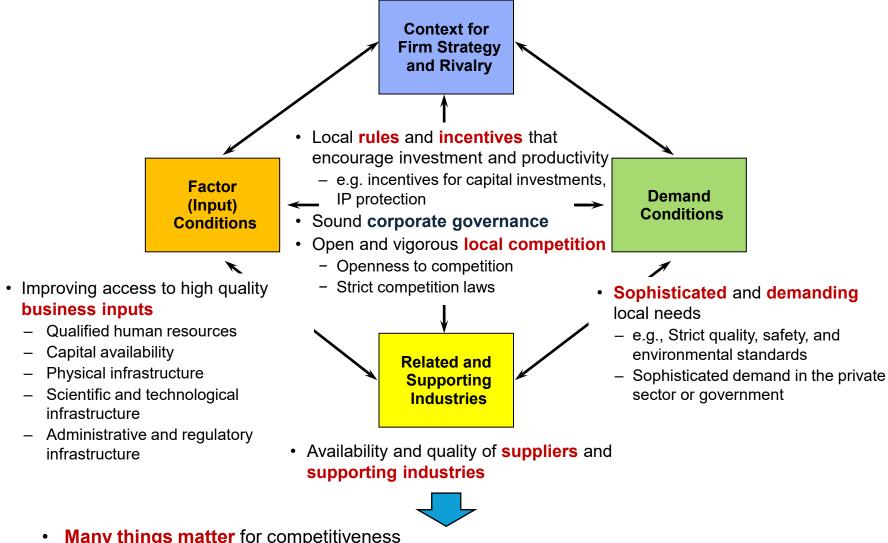

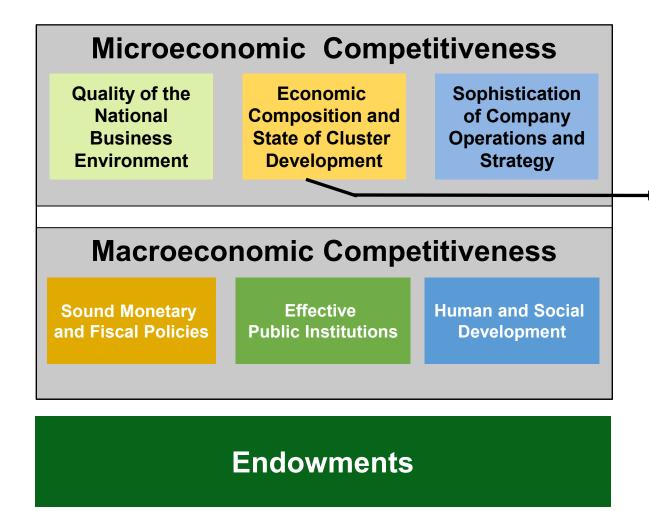

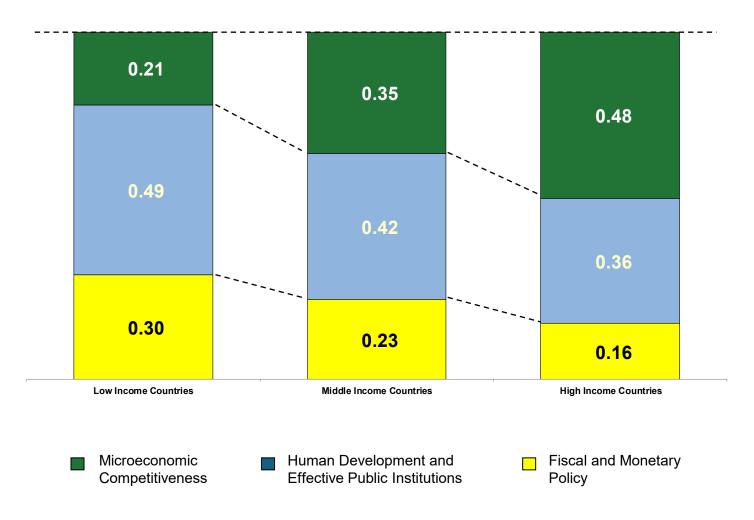

# Impact of Macro and Micro Competitiveness by Stage of Development

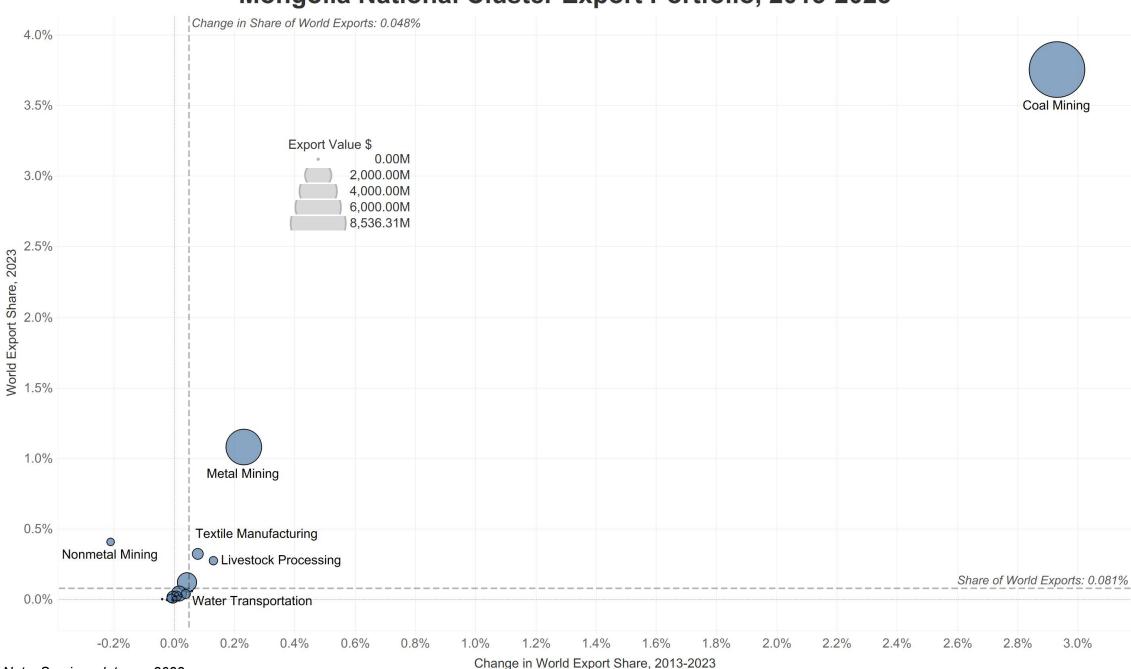

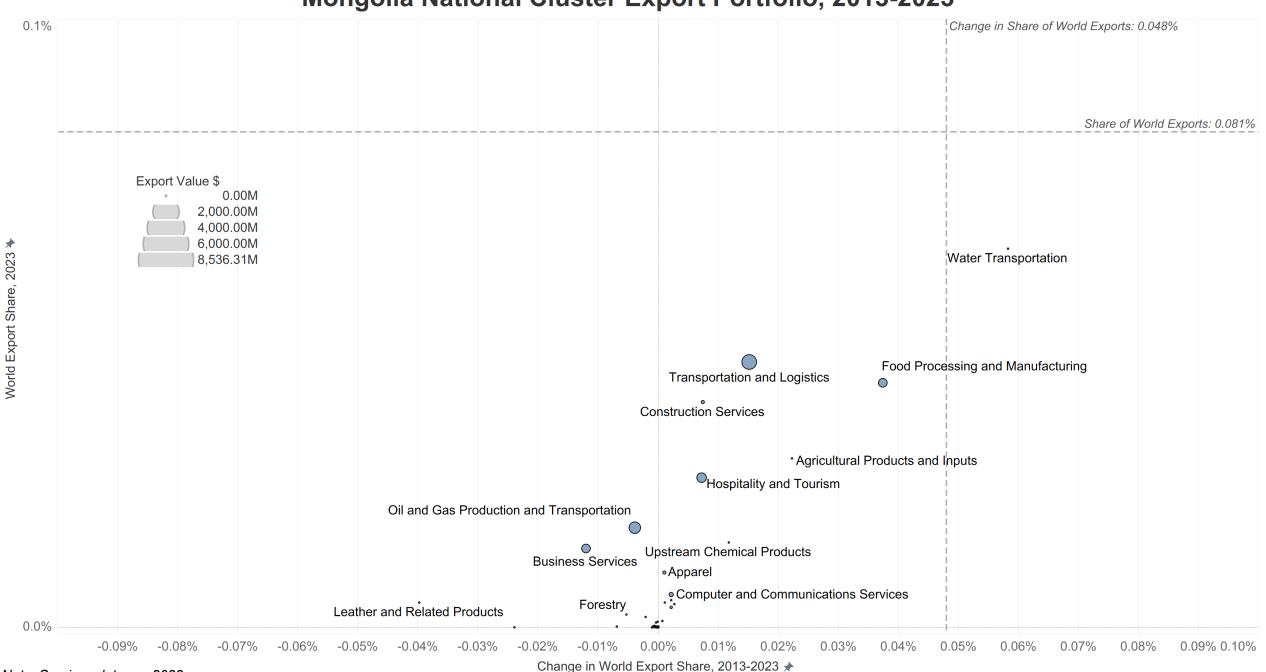

### **Mongolia Total Exports by Process Type**

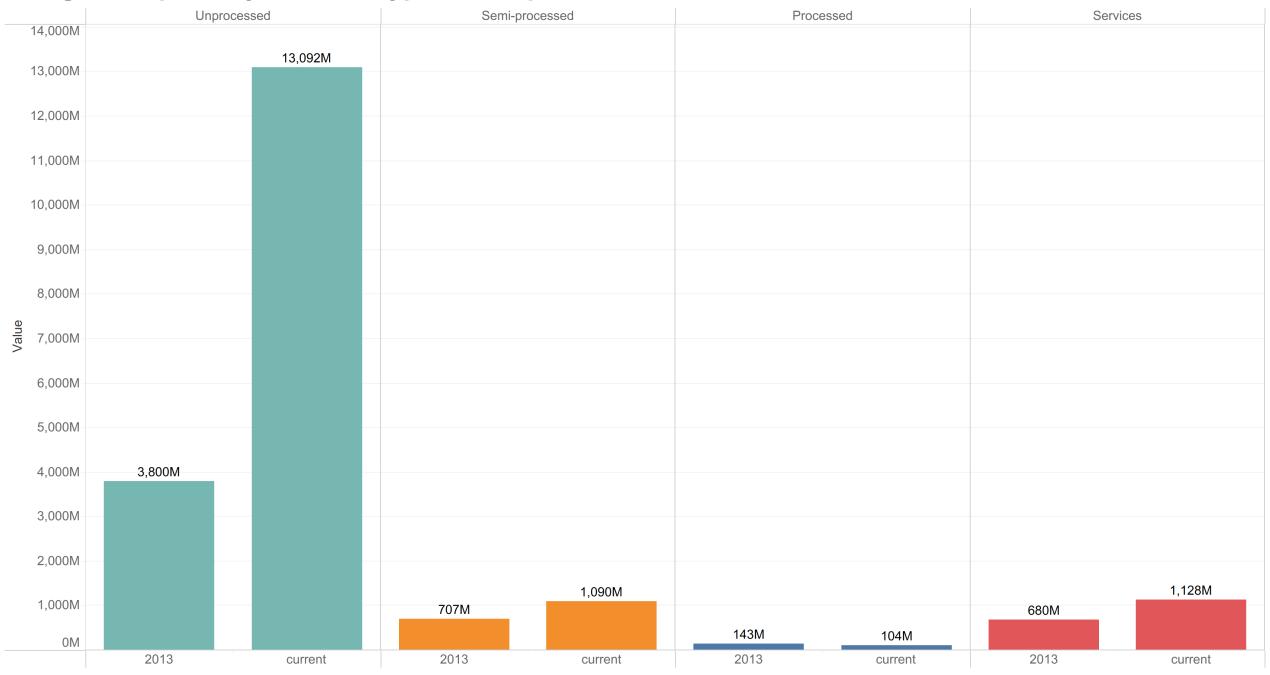

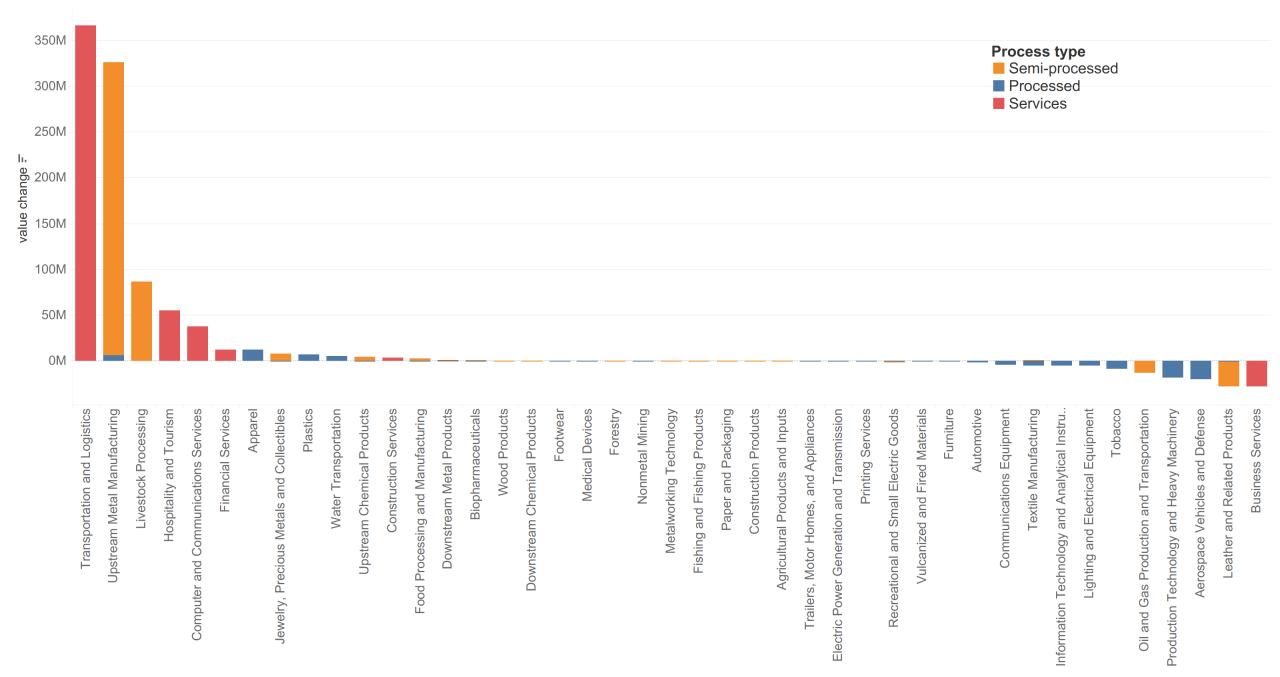

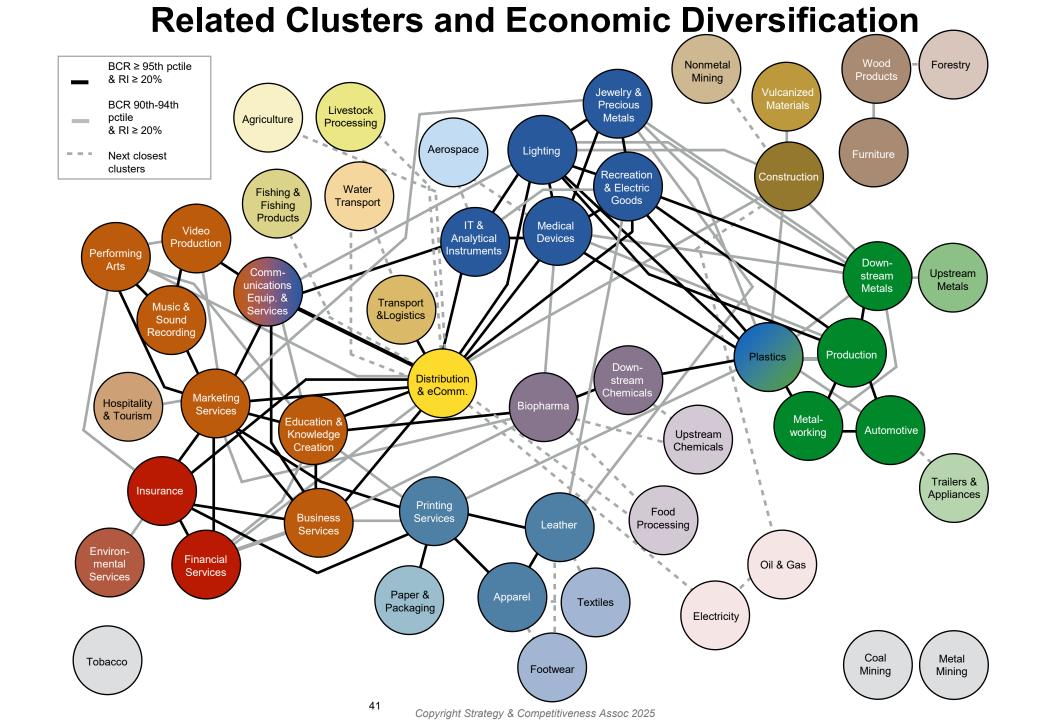

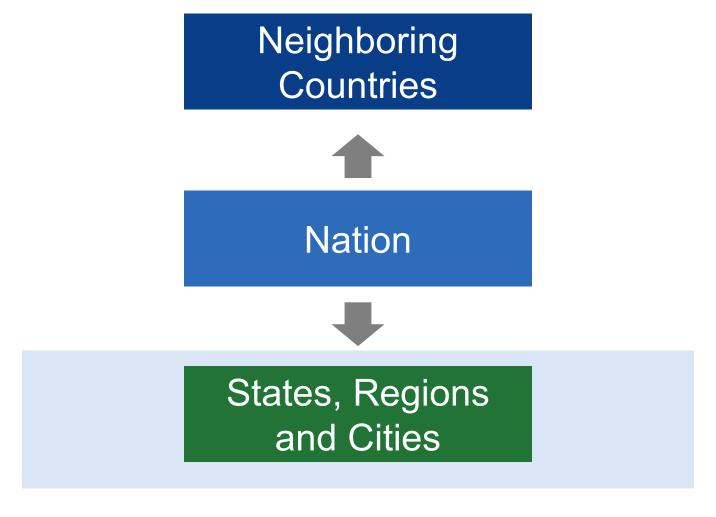


### Mongolia Related Clusters and Export Diversification, 2023
